- To stay honest and maintain unbiased behaviour.
- To focus on excellence and growth.

3. Ethical ethics - Refers to how an officer should be with the staff, the co-workers and authority.

- They should be friendly, soft-spoken and humble.
- Should respect the views and everyone's ~~opta~~ opinion.
- They should be co-operative.

4. Public ethics - Refers to how an officer should be with the general public.

- They should be unbiased and inclusive.
- They should be empathatic and concerned.
- They should be polite and interactive.
